Minutes of Jan-Sunwai

Jan-Sunwai was held on 20.11.2017 at 03:30 PM at Auditorium of APMC (MNI) Azadpur which was chaired by Secretary (MNI)/DAMB. The issues raised during Jan-Sunwai are as under:

1. Sh. Mohd. Rashid Commission Agent of Okhla Mandi had made a request for allocation of space in the existing phar in Okhla Mandi.
Secretary asked to the commission agent to give his representation and concerned branch will examine it.

Action: DS(Okhla)

2. Sh. Raman Sood STD Booth operator at Shed No- 13 & Booth No- 11 informed that he had been asked to pay the monthly electricity bill of Rs. 10000/-. He also submitted that at present in winter season refrigerators are not working and his electricity bill should be on lower side & his bill needs to be reexamined.

EE(Electric) assured that his present electricity load will be re-examined and action will be taken accordingly.

Action: EE(E)

3. Sh. Om Parkash Ahuja, President of Amrood Association raised the following issues as under:-

- (a) He informed that starting Phars in Shed No. 16 have not been given to Amrood trade. Some Potato Commission agents are unauthorisedly occupying starting two phars in Shed No 16 ,which are allotted to the Amrood Trade.

DS(E&M) assured that efforts are being made to provide required space to the Amrood trade in shed no. 16.

Action: DS(E&M)

- (b) He also informed that electricity light are not working in the entire shed no. 16 hence arrangement be made to improve the situation of electricity (LED) in shed no. 16.

Action: EE(E)

4. Sh. Subash Chug Commission Agent of tomato trade raised the following issues as under:-

- (a) He informed that traders (31 traders) have been allotted 2.5 Phar in the common space in tomato shed are facing difficulty in selling their commodity because of insanitary conditions in the common space hence need immediate attention towards the cleaning of common phar.

Action: EE(Civil)

- (b) He also informed that trader of phar no. 1,2 & 3 have blocked the inter-moving space between the Common Phar and rest of the Phars of Tomato trade. It creates problem to the customers from moving other Phar to Common Phar. Hence

blockage made by the commission agents of Phar No 1,2&3 needs to be removed immediately.

Action: DS(Enf)/DS(S)

- (c) He also informed that high mast light near Shop No. D-403 is not working for the last 3 months and traders are facing lot of problem.

Action: EE(E)

5. Haji Mohd. Shahid Kurashi has raised the issue of allotment of shop in new shops in any of the mandi in Delhi and requested that he must be allotted shop at Ghazipur or other mandi as he was the old market functionary of the old Dariya Ganj Mandi .

Secretary informed that determination of current market rate of shops is under process and e-auction will take place thereafter for the remaining unallotted shops in Ghazipur and Keshopur will take place as per rules and approvals.

6. Sh. Umesh Aggarwal, Commission Agent of Potato trade raised the following issues:-

- (a) Sulabh Sochalaya are overcharging in APMC Azadpur. He suggested that the use of Sulabh Sochalaya be made free of cost as it has been done DUSIB department.

Action: EE(Civil)

- (b) He also suggested entry of empty vehicle for loading in mandi be extended upto 11 AM on Sunday.

DS(Gate) assured that action will be taken to smoothen flow of traffic in the Mandi & simultaneously process of loading/ unloading does not hamper.

Action: DS(Gate)

- (c) He also highlighted the issue of rejection of Renewel of 130 licensee due to non-arrival of any commodity in the preceding year.

Action: DS(Lic)


- (d) Problem of parking is also highlighted by the trader.

Action: DS(S)

7. Sh. Bhoj Chand commission agent of shop no. C-510 informed that he had applied for change of constitution of his firm and nothing has been done in the last 8 months.

DS(LIC) informed that earlier change of constitution of the firm of the licensee could not take place as there was no market committee in APMC for the last 1 year. Now the new market committee had been constituted vide notification dt. 07/11/2017. Hence all the pending cases will be settled in the coming meeting of the marketing committee.

It was assured in the meeting that steps would be taken to address the grievances and problems of the mandi stake holders & meeting ended with thanks to the chair.
