4. Tender shall be valid for 90 days form the date of opening of Financial bid. APMC reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason.

2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful tenderer on prescribed Form No. CPWD 8, which is available as a Govt. of India Publication. Tenderer shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form, which will form part of the agreement.
3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **45 days** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the tender documents.
4. The site for the work is available or the site for the work shall be made available in parts as specified below.

7. The contractor, whose tender is accepted, will be required to furnish performance guarantee of 5% (Five percent) of the tendered amount within the period specified in Schedule 'F'. Tenderers are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their tender. A tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charges consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The tenderer shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a tender by a tenderer implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications

of the work to be done and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.

9. The competent authority does not bind himself to accept the lowest or any other tender and reserves to himself the authority to reject any or all the tenders received without the assignment of any reason. All tenders in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the tenderer shall be summarily rejected.
10. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
11. The competent authority reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
12. The contractor shall not be permitted to tender for works in the CPWD / PWD Circle (responsible for award and execution of contracts) in which his near relative is posted as Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazetted officer in the Public Works Department or in the Ministry of Urban Development. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.
13. No Engineer of gazetted rank or other Gazetted officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of two years after his retirement from Government service, without the previous permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the contractors service.
14. The tender for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 90 (Ninety) days from the date of opening of tenders. If any tenderer withdraws his tender before the said period or issue of letter of acceptance, which ever is earlier or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the department, then the APMC shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit entire the said earnest money as absolutely.

Contractor shall procure 33 grade (conforming to IS 269) or 43 grade (conforming to IS: 8112) ordinary Portland cement, as required in the work, from reputed manufacturer of cement, having a production capacity of one million tones per annum or more, one million tones per annum or more, such as ACC L&T, J.P. Rewa, Vikram Shri Cement, Birla Jute and cement corporation of India etc. as approved by Ministry of Industry, Govt of India and holding license to use ISI certification mark for their product whose name shall be got approved from Engineer-in-charge. Supply of cement.	The contractor shall procure 33 grade (conforming to IS 269_ or 43 grade (conforming to IS:8112) ordinary Portland cement, as required in the work, from reputed manufacturer of cement, having a production capacity of one million tones or more , such as ACC, L&T, J.P. Rewa, Vikram shri Cement, Birla Jute and cement corporation of India etc. i.e. agencies approved Ministry of Industry, govt. of India and holding license to use ISI certification mark for their project. The tender accepting also submit a list of names of cement manufactures, which they propose to use in the work. The tender accepting authority reserves right to accept or reject name(s) of cement manufacture(s), which the tenderer proposed to use in the work. No change in the tendered rates will be accepted if the tender accepting authority does not accept the list of cement manufactures, given by the tenderer, fully or partially, supply of cement.....

Chief Engineer of Zones are to change the brand in the condition for cement depending upon availability in local market. If needed. Instruction in this respect can be issued by them at regular intervals.

The name of cement manufactures should be finalized after taking into consideration the suggestion of contractors during a perbid meeting

For smaller value works, where perbid meeting is not necessary, the NIT approving authority shall have to specify the approved names.

Similar conditions for cement of other types like slag cement etc. may be incorporated wherever required by the NIT approving authority by providing for relevant BIS codes, suitable brands of cement and technical circulars issued by the department.

SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The Agency/Contractor should engage the employees of age between 18-40 years.
2. The Agency/Contractor should provide all the necessary apparatus, T & P, machinery & equipment to the employees engaged for the said work.
3. The Agency/Contractor should manage/provide all the safety equipment, required, to the employees engaged for the said work.
4. The Agency/Contractor should ensure that all the employees engaged in the work are following/adopting the safety procedures properly and accurately.
5. The Agency/Contractor shall be solely responsible for any breach in safety measures adopted by their/his employees for the work.
6. The Agency/Contractor shall be solely held responsible if any mis-happening occurs to their/his employees during the work irrespective of cause or nature.
7. The APMC shall not compensate any loss to the Agency/ Contractor, of any nature if occurs during the execution of the work.
8. The Agency/Contractor shall not engage any sub-contractor or transfer the contract to any other person in any matter.
9. In case of any dispute/difference the Secretary, APMC, Azadpur shall refer the matter to sole arbitrator to be appointed by him/her and the award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding to both the parties.
10. The Agency/Contractor shall be responsible to follow all the rules, regulations and instructions of the Govt., MCD, DDA, APMC & any court of law etc.
11. The APMC shall not be responsible for making any payment to ESI, EPF etc. for the employed engaged by the tenderer/contractor.
12. In respect of order passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P.(C) 5232/2007 titled "National Campaign for Dignity & Rights of Sewerage & Allied Workers Versus MCD & Others", the following special conditions will be strictly implementation while undertaking the work of sewage cleaning at the place of work:
13. All necessary personal safety equipment & protective gears as stipulated be kept available for the use of the person employed on the site and maintained in a condition suitable for immediate use, and the contractor should take adequate steps to ensure proper use of equipment by those concerned before the worker is allowed to enter.
14. Entry for workers in the sewer line/ manholes shall not be allowed except under supervision of JE / SPM and responsible authorized representative of the contractor.
15. Before entry, presence of toxic gases be tested by inserting wet lead acetate paper which changes colour in presence of such gases and give indication of presence.
16. Presence of oxygen is verified by lowering a detector lamp into the man hole. In case, no oxygen is found inside the sewer line, workers should be sent only with oxygen kit.
17. The workers engaged for cleaning the manholes/ sewers should be properly trained before allowing working in the manholes.
18. The workers are employed in sewer and manholes shall be provided with protected gears like gum boots, helmets, gloves, PVC protective body suits, gas mask with oxygen cylinder, torch and safety belt with rope.
19. The worker should not be allowed to work inside the manhole continuously. He should be given rest intermittently.

20. Air blowers should be used for flow of fresh air through the manholes. Whenever called for portable air blowers should be used for ventilating the manholes.
21. The workers shall be issued an Employed Card in form-14 of the CL(R&A) central rules 1971 within three days of the employment of the worker by the contractor.
22. The worker shall be got medically examined before the commencement of work and at a regular interval and fortnight free of cost and copies of medical records shall be furnished in the office of Manager (CT).
23. The worker diagnosed with medical disease that is medically not suitable for cleaning of sewer manholes as per the advice of doctor, shall not be permitted to be deployed on such type of works.
24. During the executing of the work, if a worker is diagnosed with disease due to the cleaning of sewer/ manholes work, the treatment of the disease shall be given free of cost.
25. Compensation shall be paid by the respondent and recoverable from the contractor, if permissible in law, to all the workmen suffering from any occupational disease, ailment or accident in accordance with the provisions of the worker men's compensation Act, 1923.
26. On the death of any worker (at site during execution of contract) including any contract worker, an immediate ex-gratia solarium of Rs. One lacs with liberty to recover the same from contractors.
27. To ensure payment of all statutory dues such as provident fund, gratuity and bonus to all the sewer workers, including contract workers, as applicable law.
28. To provide restroom and canteens including therein first-aid facilities, safe drinking water, washing facilities, latrines and urinals, shelters crèches as per applicable model rules.
29. A proper record of all the happening in the site order book shall be maintained which shall include:-
30. Provision of safety equipment to the contractor.
31. The date about pre-inspection of sewer line before entering.
32. Training to safety workers.
33. Use of safety workers.
34. Barricading of working site.
35. History card of sewer workers and equipment's.
36. Daily record of work performed.
37. Videography and photography of all the desilting work executed shall be got done as proof of the work.
