3. The principal yard of APMC, Azadpur is divided in 3-parts namely, New Subzi Mandi (**NSM**), Cement Godown Area and New Fruit Mandi (**NFM**). The traders of Barafkhana, Old Delhi were shifted (July 12, 1975) to NSM, Azadpur on the DDA allotted shops. The DDA maintained the mandi till Dec 1, 1979 whereafter it was handed over to the APMC. Later on more area was allotted to APMC by the DDA on which NFM was set up. Thus, the NSM area has DDA allotted shops, and the Cement Godown and NFM area has open auction sheds. The sub-yard Okhla also has DDA constructed shops and auction sheds. The Kela siding, Azadpur land is taken on lease from the Indian Railways where commodities (Banana, Orange and Mango) come in railway wagons from Southern part of India and are traded there itself.

4. **MAJOR ONGOING PROJECTS:**

1. Improvement and Strengthening of roads by cement concrete in NSM & NFM, Azadpur.
2. Reconstruction of Shed No.14 (Part II) in NFM.
3. Remodeling of entry/exit gates in NSM & NFM.
4. Repair of Dhallaos and Piaoos in NSM & NFM.
5. Construction of water piaos (3 nos.), including providing & installation of chiller plant at NSM & NFM.
6. Renovation of boundary wall, barriers at entry & exit at subyard Okhla.
7. Repair/Reconstruction of Urinal blocks, repair/maintenance of water booths at subyard Okhla.
8. Purchase of Sanitation vehicles.
9. Fresh tendering of outsourced Sanitation & Security services.

5. **MAJOR PROJECTS IN PIPELINE TO BE UNDERTAKEN:**

1. Development of Cement Godown area.
2. Reconstruction of POMA shed.
3. Reconstruction of all the sheds in Cement Godown & NFM area.

6. **MAJOR PROJECTS AWAITING PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT:**

1. Development of Tikri Khampur area (about 70 acres).
2. Development of Mangolpuri mandi (about 11 acres) as F& V market, which was till recently used as fodder market.
3. Development of Transport centre (about 6.67 acres) after taking over the possession of the same from the DDA.

7. **MAJOR ISSUES PENDING ACTION:**

1. Notification of various commodities being traded in the mandi area to increase revenue.
2. Notification of charging of 6% commission from the buyers instead of farmers/sellers.
3. Re-framing of licence policy to implement government notification dated 22.09.14 relaxing requirement of possessing premises in the notified yards/subyards before applying for a licence.
