MINUTES OF JANSUNWAI

As scheduled meeting of Jansunwai was held on 25.07.2018 at 03:00 P.M. in the Conference Hall of APMC (MNI) Azadpur which was chaired by Secretary, APMC (MNI) Azadpur & Sh. Anil Ghidyal, Secretary FMC, Gazipur was also present as an observer. The issues raised during Jan-Sunwai are as under: -

1. Sh. Umesh Kr. Potato commission agent from Shop No. A-266 raised the following points: -

(i) Requested for private bank gateway facility for online payment of market fees be provided.

Secretary (MNI) informed that as per DAPM(R) Act 1998 only nationalized bank's gateway can be used for payment of market fee.

(ii) He also requested for open the canteen in Kissan Bhawan.

Secretary(MNI) directed to all concerned officers to take the necessary action for open the Canteen positively from 1st August 2018 & EE(C) & EE(E) must ensure basic facilities of Water, Electricity, Toilet are provided & are functional before 31/07/2018.

Action: EE(C)/ EE(E)/DS(CT)

(iii) He also requested to place Divider on the road from Shed No. 13 & Ch. Hira Singh Park.

Action: EE(C)

2. Sh. Om Parkash Ahuja, Shop No. B-155 (President Amrood Association) informed that at Gate no 5 gate staff is not issuing the gate Pass of Pears & Mango simultaneously & Driver has to go on two gates for issuing Gate Pass of Pears & Mango & requested that in such cases Gate Pass be allowed from one Gate.

Secretary(MNI) directed to DS(Gate) to issue gate pass from every Gate office for all commodities of the vehicle.

Action: DS(Gate)

3. Sh. Sumit Kumar, requested for restoration of his A Category Licence. As earlier A & B Category of licencee were not renewed due to non-arrival of commodity in the year 2017.

Secretary (MNI) asked him to apply for issue of fresh license as the earlier decision was taken as per law.

Action: DS (Lic.)

4. Sh. Bijender Tyagi, prop. of the firm M/s. Devinder Kr. Bijender & Co., Shop No. D-1310 requested for auction space in Green Vegetable. He also informed that some traders have given their phar on rent basis where as APMC has given them free of cost.

Secretary (MNI) asked him to submit a written complaint against those traders who have given their phars on rent in Sangham Shed.

Action: DS (E&M)

5. Sh. Sanjay Kumar, Palledar, informed that at Shed No. 7,8 & 10 the Dallas lights and fans are not working order.

Secretary (MNI) directed to EE (E) & AE(E) that at Shed No. 7 the problem of Dalla Lights & non functionary of Fan must be resolved upto 5th Aug.2018 & problem of Dalla Lights & non functionary of Fan at Shed No. 8 & 10 be resolved within 24 hours.

Action: EE (E)

6. Prop. of firm M/s. Sunil Trading Co. raised the issues as under: -

- (i) He informed that in front of Onion Shed there is garbage lying in the road.

Secretary (MNI) suggested to the licensee to ask their truck drivers not to throw the garbage in front of sheds & help APMC in maintaining cleanliness in Mandi as APMC alone cannot keep entire mandi clean. He directed EE(C) for cleaning of the place.

Action: EE(C)

- (ii) He also informed that at Onion shed the louvers sheet were not installed & rain water comes inside the shed.

Secretary (MNI) directed to EE(C) to resolve the rain water problem & installed the louvers sheet upto 5th August 2018 positively.

Action: EE (C)

7. Prop. of M/s Bhagwan Dass & Sons informed that the road from Police Chowki to half of New built part of shed no 20 is broken & needs immediate repair. •

Secretary (MNI) directed to EE(C) to issue a letter to Contractor for repairing of the road within the period of One month. EE(C) & AE(C) will give the certificate in this regard.

Action: EE (C)

8. Sh. Rajesh Kumar form M/s. Maha Laxmi Traders raised the issues as under:-

- (i) He informed that the road in front of Onion Shed is broken and there is a big Pit in the road for the last 3 to 4 months.

Secretary (MNI) asked to EE(C) & AE(C) NSM to fill the Pits within 24 hours & action taken report be submit in this regard.

Action: EE(C)

- (ii) He informed that there is always traffic Jam on the road in front of Onion Shed and Security Guard are also not working properly.

Secretary (MNI) informed that Jam is due to encroachment on roads. Trade Association were advised not to allow encroachment on road opposite their auction sheds. DS(S) & DS(Enf.) were also directed to resolve the problem.

Action: DS (Security)/DS(Enf.)



9. Sh. Akeel Ahmad from Shop No. A-341 informed that near Transformer & Toilet block at A & B chowk there is encroachment due to which there is a traffic Jam. Action to be taken by DS(Enf.) & DS(Security).

Action: DS(Enf.)/DS(S)

10. Prop of M/s Shri Radhey Garlic, Shop No. A-281 raised the issues as under:-

- (i) He informed that the road in front of his shop is in very bad condition.

Secretary (MNI) asked to EE(C) to take the remedial measure for repairing the broken road in front of shop no. A-281 immediately.

Action : EE(C)

- (ii) He also requested for auction space for Garlic trade.

Action :DS(E&M)

11. Representative of the Inderprastha Cold Storage requested for opening of the entry of Frozen /Processed food items in APMC Azadpur.

Secretary (MNI) asked him to give his representation in writing regarding his submissions for evaluation as per law.

Action : DS(E&M)

12. Some traders of Mosambi commodity informed that in half Phar it is not possible to conduct the business of Mosambi trade, hence ½ Phar Category criteria may not be considered at the time of allotment of Mosambi trade.

Secretary (MNI) informed that in earlier allotments of half phars have been given to Commission Agents. Further decision is taken by Committee.

Action: DS(E&M)

13. Prop. of M/s Pappu Kohli & Sons Garlic trader requested that he may be allowed to store Garlic outside his shop about 10 feet:

Secretary(MNI) rejected the request and said that no encroachment can be allowed.

14. Secretary(MNI) directed All EEs, AEs, & JEs to do field visit on every day during first half & resolve the problem of traders without delay.

Action: All EEs/AEs/JEs (Civil & Elec.)

At the end, it was assured by Secretary (MNI) in the meeting that steps would be taken to address the grievances and problems of the Mandi stake holders at the earliest.
